An Act relating to Jury Lists in District and Local Courts.

[Assented to, October 5th, 1905.]

PE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Jury Act Amendment Act, short title. 1905," and shall be incorporated and read with "The Jury Act, 1862," and all Acts amending the same.
- 2. The jurors' rolls now in use in the Local Courts of the State Local Courts jury shall continue in operation and be valid and effectual for all pur- lists to continue in poses until the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and nine.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 2 of "The Criminal Radius from which Jurors Payment Act," No. 511 of 1891, the limit of radius within jurors may be summoned extended which any person shall be summoned as a juror to attend the sittings of the Circuit Court of any Circuit District is hereby extended to apply to persons who shall reside not more than twenty-five miles from the place at which the sittings of the said Circuit Court are to be held.
