An Act to amend "The Third Judge and District
Courts Act," and the Act No. 6 of 1868-9.

[*Assented to, November 21st, 1883.*]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Preamble.
Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present
Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Third Judge and District Courts Act," or in the Act No. 6 of 1868-9, in the event of any Judge named in any commission under the first-mentioned Act not attending at the time and place appointed for holding any Circuit Court, it shall be lawful for any other Judge of the Supreme Court to hold such Circuit Court according to the tenor of such commission, and as if he had been named therein. In event of non-attendance of Judge named in commission any other Judge may hold Circuit Court.
