An Act to further amend "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Act."

[Assented to, September 7th, 1911.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Further Amendment Act, 1911." Short title.

(2) The "Lands Clauses Consolidation Act," the Act entitled an Act to amend the "Land Clauses Consolidation Act," being the Act No. 26 of 1855-6, the "Lands Clauses Consolidation Amendment Act, 1881," and this Act, may be cited together as "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Acts, 1847 to 1911."

2. This Act is incorporated with the Acts mentioned in section 1, and those Acts and this Act shall be read and construed as one Act. Incorporation.

3. This Act shall apply to every undertaking heretofore authorised or hereafter to be authorised by any Act. Act to apply to undertaking whenever authorised.

4. In any case in which payment into or deposit in a bank of purchase-money or compensation or an amount by way of security is prescribed or allowed by "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Act," it shall be lawful and sufficient to pay the same directly into the Supreme Moneys may be paid into Court instead of into bank.

The Lands Clauses Consolidation Further Amendment Act.—1911.
