An Act to amend "The Mining Act, 1893."

[*Assented to, November 24th, 1904.*]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Mining Act Amendment Act, 1904." Short title.

2. The provisions of Part IV. of "The Mining Act, 1893," shall extend to every stone or flux quarry on private or Crown lands, and every such quarry shall, for the purposes of such Part, be deemed to be a mine, and the work done in such quarry shall be deemed to be mining. Part IV., Mining Act, 1893, to apply to quarries.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
