An Act to amend the Married Women's Property Acts.

[Assented to, November 13th, 1902.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Parliament of South Australia, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Married Women's Property short title. Amendment Act, 1902."

2. A married woman and her property shall be liable and subject Judgment against to all such proceedings and other remedies upon any judgment against her in any Court of Justice as might be had or taken upon a judgment against her if she were unmarried, except that execution shall not issue against her property which is subject to a restraint upon anticipation.
