An Act to amend "The Northern Territory Land Act, 1899."

[Assented to, December 21st, 1901.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Parliament of South Australia, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Northern Territory Land Amendment Act, 1901," and, except so far as inconsistent therewith, shall be incorporated and read as one with "The Northern Territory Crown Lands Act, 1890," and "The Northern Territory Land Act, 1899."

Short title and incorporation.

2. Sub-section 11. of section 54 of "The Northern Territory Land Act, 1899," is hereby repealed, and, notwithstanding anything contained in the said Act, the Governor shall not after the passing of this Act resume possession of any leased land except for the purposes contained and set forth in sub-section 1. of the said section 54, or when such land is required for agricultural purposes.

Repeal.

Resumption of lands.

3. Where it is intended to resume any land for agricultural purposes two years' notice of such intended resumption shall be given to the lessee.

Procedure on resumption.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
