An Act to amend "The Institutes Further Amendment Act, 1902."

[Assented to, September 30th, 1903.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Parliament of South Australia, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Public Library, Museum, and Art Gallery Act, 1903," and, except so far as inconsistent therewith, shall be incorporated and read as one with the Public Library, Museum, and Art Gallery Acts, 1883-4, 1885, and 1895, and all Acts amending those Acts.

Short title and incorporation.

2. Section 17 of "The Institutes Further Amendment Act, 1902," is hereby repealed, and sub-section 1. of section 7 of the "Public Library, Museum, and Art Gallery Act, 1883-4," is hereby revived.

Repeal of section 17 of No. 800 of 1902 and revival of sub-section 1. of section 7 of "Public Library, Museum, and Art Gallery Act, 1883-4."

3. From and after the first day of October, one thousand nine hundred and three, the Board of Governors of the Public Library, Museum, and Art Gallery of South Australia shall consist of eighteen members, and section 7 of the "Public Library, Museum, and Art Gallery Act, 1883-4," shall be read as if the word "sixteen" in the second line of that section were struck out, and the word "eighteen" inserted in lieu thereof.

Constitution of Board of Governors.
