An Act to amend "The Stock Diseases Act, 1888,"
and for other purposes.

[*Assented to, October 30th, 1903.*]

BE it Enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of
the Parliament of South Australia, as follows:

- 1.** This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Stock Diseases Act Amendment Act, 1903," and shall be incorporated and read with "The Stock Diseases Act, 1888," hereinafter called the principal Act.

Short title and incorporation.
- 2.** Whenever the Commissioner is satisfied that any infected stock should be quarantined or destroyed in order to eradicate any disease, or prevent the spreading of any disease, he may order that such infected stock, or any articles or things used in connection with any infected stock, shall be forthwith quarantined or destroyed by the owner under the direction of an Inspector, and at such time and place as such Inspector may determine.

Infected stock may be quarantined or destroyed.

- 3.** When infected stock is destroyed pursuant to any order of the Commissioner, the owner shall receive compensation from the Government of the State for such infected stock which, when destroyed, is found to be free from any disease.

- 4.** The rate of compensation shall be three-fourths of the actual current value of healthy stock and articles and things destroyed of the same description as the infected stock destroyed, and such compensation shall be subject to the deductions provided in section 5 hereof.

5. The owner shall realise upon any stock killed which after being killed is found to be free from disease, and shall immediately thereafter furnish the Inspector under whose direction the same was killed with a true statement of such realisation; and the amount received therefor shall be deducted from the compensation payable to such owner.

6. This amending Act shall apply only to swine which are infected stock.
