An Act to amend the Vermin Acts, 1914 to 1923, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, December 18th, 1924.]

E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Vermin Act Further Amend-Short titles. ment Act, 1924."
- (2) The Vermin Acts, 1914 to 1923, and this Act may be cited together as the "Vermin Acts, 1914 to 1924."
- (3) The Vermin Act, 1914, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act."
 - 2. Section 165 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after the word "amount" in the eleventh s. 165line of paragraph (h) thereof the passage ", including Requisites of petition. interest,";

- (b) by striking out the word "One" in the penultimate line of paragraph (h) thereof and substituting therefor the word "Two"; and
- (c) by striking out the word "One" in the last line of paragraph (h) thereof and substituting therefor the word "Two."
- 3. Section 201 of the principal Act is repealed.

- 4. Section 202 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out the word "boundary" in the second line thereof; and
 - (b) by repealing subsection (2) thereof.

- 5. Section 205 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "boundary" in the first line thereof.
- 6. (1) Section 9 of the Vermin Act Further Amendment Act, 1919, is amended by inserting after the word "Board" in the fitth line thereof the words "or any land vested in any District Council by virtue of the provisions of the South-Eastern Drainage Act, 1878, or the South-Eastern Drainage Act Amendment Act, 1908."
- (2) Section 8 of the principal Act shall be read so as to give effect to the provisions of this section.
