An Act to amend the Vermin Act, 1931-1957.

[Assented to 3rd December, 1959.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Vermin Act Amendment Act, 1959".
- (2) The Vermin Act, 1931-1957, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Vermin Act, 1931-1959".
- (3) The Vermin Act, 1931-1957, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 22a— Prevision for destruction of rabbit burrows. 3. Subsection (1) of section 22a of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "within the time specified in the notice" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "one month from the date of the giving of the said notice or such further period as is specified in the notice".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 23—

- Penalty for not destroying vermin during simultaneous destruction period or after notice.
- 4. Section 23 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—
 - (5) In this section the expression "physical features" means unusual topographical features such as water-courses, ravines, hills and the like and does not mean the size or area of land as such.
