An Act to amend the Vermin Act, 1931-1942.

[Assented to 21st October, 1943.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the " Vermin Act Amendment Act, 1943 ".

(2) The Vermin Act, 1931-1942, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the " Vermin Act, 1931-1943 ".

(3) The Vermin Act, 1931-1942, is hereinafter referred to as " the principal Act. "

2. Section 76 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words " six weeks " in paragraph III. thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words " two months ".
