An Act to amend the Waterworks Act, 1932-1966.

[Assented to 4th December, 1969.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Waterworks Act Amendment Act, 1969". Short titles.
- (2) The Waterworks Act, 1932-1966, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Waterworks Act, 1932-1969".
- (3) The Waterworks Act, 1932-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the definition of "street" the following definition :— Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—
Interpretation.

"the Land and Valuation Court" means the Land and Valuation Court constituted under the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1969 .:

4. Section 78 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is enacted and inserted in its place :— Repeal of s. 78 of principal Act and enactment of section in its place.
Court of appeal.

78. (1) The jurisdiction to hear and determine appeals made pursuant to section 76 and section 77 of this Act shall be vested in the Land and Valuation Court.

(2) An appeal must be instituted within the period allowed for appealing in accordance with the appropriate rules of the Supreme Court.

5. Section 79 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection :—

(1) An appeal shall be heard as soon as practicable after the expiration of five weeks from the publication in the *Gazette* of the notice of assessment or alteration of the assessment. ;

(b) by striking out from subsection (3) the passage “at the same or at some adjourned or subsequent sittings” ;

and

(c) by striking out subsections (4) and (5).

**Repeal of
s. 80 of
principal Act.**

6. Section 80 of the principal Act is repealed.
