An Act to amend the Weights and Measures Act, 1934.

[Assented to 11th August, 1938.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Weights and Measures Act Amendment Act, 1938". Short title.

(2) The Weights and Measures Act, 1934, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Weights and Measures Act, 1934-1938".

(3) The Weights and Measures Act, 1934, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 30 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection :— Amendment of principal Act, s. 30—

(3) This section shall not apply to bread when offered or exposed for sale in any vehicle, pack, basket, or other receptacle. Exemptions.
