An Act to amend "The Water Conservation Act, 1886."

[Assented to, December 8th, 1888.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows: Preamble.

1. This Act shall be incorporated and read as one with "The Water Conservation Act, 1886." Incorporation.

2. Sections 139 and 145 of "The Water Conservation Act of 1886," are hereby repealed. Repeal.

3. The Commissioner of Public Works for the time being shall be the Commissioner of Water Conservation. Commissioner.

4. The Commissioner may grant leases for any term not exceeding twenty-one years of any lands, waterworks, powers, or premises vested in him or under his control, and may accept surrenders of any such leases, and such leases and surrenders may be granted and accepted on such terms as may be thought fit. Power to lease and surrender.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
