An Act to amend the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1911.

[Assented to, December 5th, 1918.]

E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Workmen's Com-Short titles. pensation Act Amendment Act, 1918."
- (2) The Workmen's Compensation Act, 1911 (hereinafter called No. 1053 of 1911. "the principal Act") and this Act may be cited together as the "Workmen's Compensation Acts, 1911 and 1918."
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act, and that Act Incorporation with other Acts. and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. Paragraph (1) of the First Schedule to the principal Act is Amendment of First amended as follows:—

principal Act

1. By substituting the word "Four" for the word "Three" Amount of in the seventh line thereof:

compensation.

- 11. By substituting the words "Thirty Shillings in the case of a single man and Two Pounds in the case of a married man" for the words "One Pound" in the twenty-eighth line thereof:
- 111. By substituting the word "Four" for the word "Three" in the twenty-ninth line thereof.
