## No. 15 of 1970

An Act to amend the Wild Dogs Act, 1931-1961

[Assented to 17th September, 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

**Short titles.**

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Wild Dogs Act Amendment Act, 1970".

(2) The Wild Dogs Act, 1931-1961, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Wild Dogs Act, 1931-1970".

(3) The Wild Dogs Act, 1931-1961, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

**Amendment of principal Act, s. 5—  
Imposition of rates.**

2. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from paragraph I of the proviso to subsection (1) the passage "one shilling and sixpence" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "twenty-five cents".

**Amendment of principal Act, s. 8—  
Subsidies to fund.**

3. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (2).

4. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from the proviso to subsection (1) the passage "four thousand pounds" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "fifty thousand dollars".
