An Act to amend the Wild Dogs Act, 1931-1951.

[Assented to 8th October, 1953.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Wild Dogs Act Amendment Act, 1953".
- (2) The Wild Dogs Act, 1931-1951, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Wild Dogs Act, 1931-1953".
- (3) The Wild Dogs Act, 1931-1951, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 5—Rate.

2. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "shilling" in the twelfth line of subsection (2) thereof the words "and sixpence".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 9— Advances by Governor.

3. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "two" in the last line of subsection (1) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "four".
