An Act to amend the Wild Dogs Act, 1931-1951.

[Assented to 8th October, 1953.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the " Wild Dogs Act Amendment Act, 1953 ".

(2) The Wild Dogs Act, 1931-1951, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the " Wild Dogs Act, 1931-1953 ".

(3) The Wild Dogs Act, 1931-1951, is hereinafter referred to as " the principal Act ".

2. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word " shilling " in the twelfth line of subsection (2) thereof the words " and sixpence ".

3. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word " two " in the last line of subsection (1) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word " four ".
