An Act to amend the Workmen's Liens Act,
1893-1936, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 22nd October, 1964.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Workmen's Liens Act Amendment Act, 1964". Short title.
- (2) The Workmen's Liens Act, 1893-1936, as amended by this Act may be cited as the "Workmen's Liens Act, 1893-1964".
- (3) The Workmen's Liens Act, 1893-1936, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.
3. This Act shall commence on a day to be fixed by the Governor by proclamation. Commencement.
4. Subsection (3) of section 4 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "the sum of twelve" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "in either case the sum of one hundred". Amendment of principal Act, s. 4.

5. Subsection (4) of section 7 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "the sum of twelve" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "in either case the sum of one hundred".
