An Act to amend the Young Men's Christian Association of Port Pirie Act, 1918-1951.

[Assented to 30th August, 1973]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Young Men's Christian Association of Port Pirie Act Amendment Act, 1973".
- (2) The Young Men's Christian Association of Port Pirie Act, 1918-1951, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Young Men's Christian Association of Port Pirie Act, 1918-1973".
- (3) The Young Men's Christian Association of Port Pirie Act, 1918-1951, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 8— Power to mortgage. 2. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage ": Provided that the total amount of principal moneys secured by such mortgages shall not at any time exceed the sum of Three Thousand Pounds".
