APPROPRIATION.

11 GEO. VI. No. 40.

AN ACT to grant and apply a Sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Year ending on the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, and to appropriate the Supplies granted for that Year in this Session of Parliament.

[4 November, 1947.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1947-42.

- 2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Issue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted of £2,188,436 to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the 43. 6d. thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, the sum of two million one hundred and eighty-eight thousand four hundred and thirty-six pounds four shillings and six pence.
- 3 All sums granted by this Act and the Supply Act Appropriation of 1947-48, out of the Consolidated Revenue towards making supplies. good the supply granted to His Majesty, amounting, as 11 Geo. VI. appears by the first schedule, in the aggregate to the sum of No. 25. three million sixty-two thousand one hundred and ninety-six pounds four shillings and six pence, are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of those Acts for the purposes and services expressed in the second schedule to this Act.
