AN ACT to amend the Apprentices Act 1942 for the purpose of altering the length of the term for which persons may be appointed as members of the commission established under the Act, and to make special provision with respect to the making of appointments and reappointments of certain members of that commission during a certain specified period.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:----

1—This Act may be cited as the Apprentices Amendment Act Short title. 1979.

2—In this Act, the Apprentices Act 1942* is referred to as the Principal Act.

3—Section 4 (5) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting

" of 3 years " and substituting " not exceeding 3 years ".

Amendment of section 4 of Principal Act (Constitution of the commission).

Special provisions with respect to the appointments and reappointments of certain members of the commission during a certain specified period. **4**—(1) The appointment or reappointment of a person as a member of the commission during the period of 12 months commencing on the commencement of this Act (in this section referred to as "the relevant period") may be made under the Principal Act, notwithstanding that that person has not been nominated as referred to in paragraph (a), (b), (c), (d), or (e) of section 4 (4)

(2) During the relevant period, the words in subsection (1) of section 21 of the Acts Interpretation Act 1931 that follow paragraph (c) of that subsection do not apply to an appointment under that subsection in respect of the office of a member of the commission referred to in paragraph (a), (b), (c), (d), or (e) of section 4 (4) of the Principal Act.
