## ANIMALS AND BIRDS PROTECTION.

## No. 74 of 1953.

AN ACT to amend the Animals and Birds Protection 19 December, 1953.1 Act 1928.

RE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:---

Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Animals and Birds Protection Act 1953.
- (2) The Animals and Birds Protection Act 1928, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Repeal.

**2** Sections thirty-one, thirty-four, thirty-six, thirty-eight, thirty-nine, and forty of the Principal Act are repealed.

General penalty.

- 3 Section forty-seven of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the word "fifty" and substituting therefor the words "one hundred".
- 4 After section forty-eight of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:-

Proceedings to be heard by police magistrates.

"49. All proceedings in respect of an offence against this Act shall be heard and determined by a police magistrate sitting alone.".

Consequential amendments.

5 The sections of the Principal Act that are specified in the first column of the schedule to this Act are amended as respectively specified in the second column of that schedule.

Section 46	By omitting from paragraph VII. the words "for feited or liable to forfeiture" and substituting therefor the words "liable to be seized".

Section 51	By omitting the words "magistrate or justices" and substituting therefor the words "police magistrate".
