

AN ACT for the Erection of an Invalid Depôt, A.D. 1881. and for the Sale of a certain piece of Land in the Town of Launceston.

[8 November, 1881.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :--

1 It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to erect an Minister of Lands Invalid Depôt at Launceston out of moneys provided by Parliament for may erect Invalid that purpose.

2 It shall be lawful for the Minister, out of moneys provided by May purchase Parliament for that purpose, to purchase, acquire, and take, in the mode land for same. prescribed by *The Lands Clauses Act*, such land as may be necessary for the erection of the said Invalid Depôt, and such land when acquired shall be conveyed to Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors. Subject to the provisions of this Act, *The Lands Clauses Act* shall be

incorporated with this Act; and, for the purposes of such incorporation, the Minister shall be deemed to be the promoter of the undertaking.

3 The cost of the erection of the said Invalid Depôt, and of the Cost of building purchase of the land required for the same, shall not exceed the sum of and land not to Ten thousand Pounds ($\pounds 10,000$).

Commissioner of Crown Lands may sell piece of land described in Schedule. Land to be surveyed and sold under The Waste Lands Act. 34 Vict. No. 10.

Appropriation of proceeds of sale.

4 It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands, with the approbation of the Governor in Council, to sell by Public Auction, and not otherwise, the piece of land the boundaries whereof are described and set forth in the Schedule. The said piece of land shall previously to such sale be surveyed and delineated in the public charts of the Colony in such lots as are subsequently offered and put up for sale, in the manner and subject to the conditions prescribed by *The Waste Lands Act* for the sale of Town Lands in the Town of *Launceston* under the said Act; and all the provisions of the said Act shall be applicable to the sale of the said piece of land or any part thereof.

5 All sums of money received by the Colonial Treasurer on account of the sale of the said piece of land, or any part thereof, shall be paid by him to the Commissioners of "The Public Debts Sinking Fund," who shall take and hold the same under and for the purposes of "The Public Debts Sinking Fund Act, 1881;" and all the provisions contained in the said Act shall be applicable to the said sums of money in the same manner in all respects as if the same had been mentioned in the said Act.

SCHEDULE.

TOWN OF LAUNCESTON.

Bounded on the north east by four chains and eighty links or thereabouts northwesterly along the Court-house allotment and along an allotment reserved for Public School purposes, commencing at the south angle of the first-mentioned allotment on *Patterson*-street, on the north west by nine chains and forty links or thereabouts south-westerly along the proposed extension of *Cameron*-street, on the south west by five chains and eighty links south-easterly along a proposed street to *Patterson*-street aforesaid, and thence on the south east by nine chains and forty-eight links northeasterly along that street to the point of commencement.
