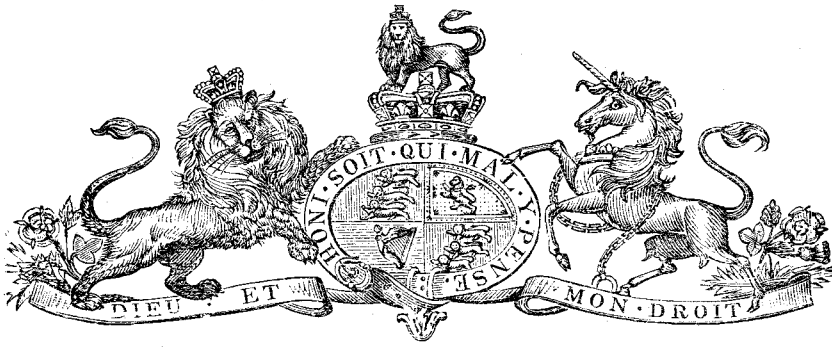

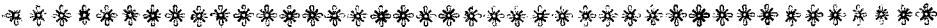

AN ACT to amend "An Act to make valid Acts done under Powers of Attorney in certain Cases." [10 November, 1891.] A.D. 1891.

WHEREAS it is desirable that provision should be made for the Registration of a Power of Attorney by filing a Notarial copy thereof instead of the original Power of Attorney: PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Section One of the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* of the 24th *Victoria*, No. 3, is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof the following shall be and be deemed to be and may be cited as Section One of the said Act; that is to say— Substitution for Sect. 1 of 24 Vict. No. 3.

"The Donee of any Power of Attorney may register such Power of Attorney by filing the same, or a Notarial copy thereof, in the Office of the Registrar of Deeds."
