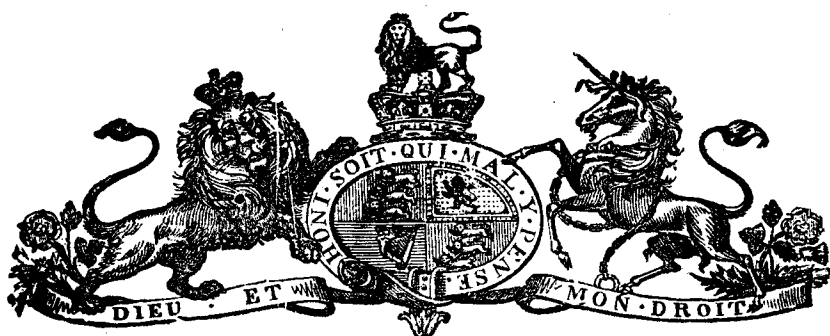

AN ACT to amend *An Act to provide temporarily for the Protection of Imported Game*, and to continue the same for a further Period. [11 December, 1877.] A.D. 1877.

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* of the 29th *Victoria*, No. 22 : PREAMBLE.

And whereas by the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* of the 40th *Victoria*, No. 24, it was enacted that the said Act should continue and be in force until the Thirty-first day of *December*, 1877, and no longer ; and it is expedient to continue the said Act for a further period :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in *An Act to provide temporarily for the Protection of Imported Game*, any person may, at any time between the First day of *May* and the Thirty-first day of *August* following, both inclusive, in every year, hunt, pursue, kill, and take Hares, by coursing with gazehounds only, and have in his house, possession, or control Hares so hunted, pursued, killed, and taken. Hares may be coursed from 1 *May* to 31 *August*.

2 The said Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* of the 29th *Victoria*, No. 22, shall, as altered by this Act, continue and be in force until the Thirty-first day of *December*, 1878, and no longer. Continues 29 *Vict.* No. 22, until 31 *December*, 1878.

3 The said Act and this Act shall, as altered by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.
