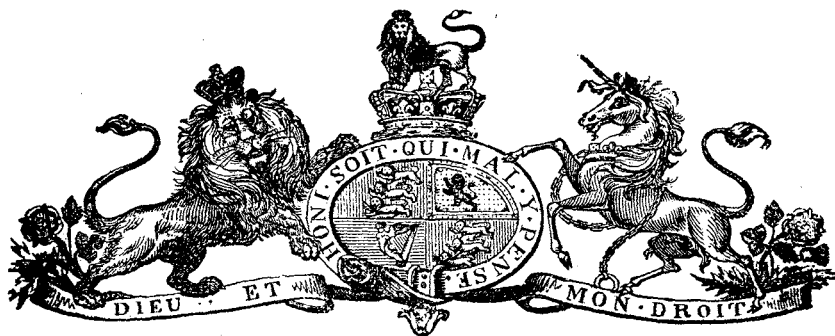

AN ACT to authorise a Grant of Three hundred Acres of the Waste Lands of the Crown to *Fanny Smith*, an Aboriginal. A.D. 1889.

[5 December, 1889.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for *Fanny Smith*, the Wife of *James Smith*, of *Nicholl's Rivulet*, Port *Cygnets*, to select, subject to the approval of the Governor in Council, and within a year after the date of this Act, Three hundred Acres of the Waste Lands of the Crown in the County of *Buckingham*; and the Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, to convey and alienate to the said *Fanny Smith*, in fee simple, such land as may be selected by her under this Act and as described in the Schedule.

*Fanny Smith* may select land, and Governor convey and alienate.

300 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

Fronting on *Nicholl's Rivulet* and bounded by lands purchased by *Thomas Smith*, *E. Ribbon*, and *William Smith* respectively, and by Crown Land.
