

AN ACT to authorise a Grant of Three A.D. 1889. hundred Acres of the Waste Lands of the Crown to Fanny Smith, an Aboriginal. [5 December, 1889.]

E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for Fanny Smith, the Wife of James Smith, of Fanny Smith Nicholl's Rivulet, Port Cygnet, to select, subject to the approval of the may select land, and Governor in Council, and within a year after the date of this Act, and Governor convey and Three hundred Acres of the Waste Lands of the Crown in the County alienate. of Buckingham; and the Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, to convey and alienate to the said Fanny Smith, in fee simple, such land as may be selected by her under this Act and as described in the Schedule.
