AN ACT to authorise a Loan of £5000 to A.D. 1897. the Marine Board of Launceston, in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890." [24 December, 1897.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to grant, in Loan may be accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans granted to Laun-Act, 1890," the sum of £5000 as a Loan to the Marine Board of Launceston for Harbour Improvements; and such moneys shall be 54 Vict. No. 30. defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.
