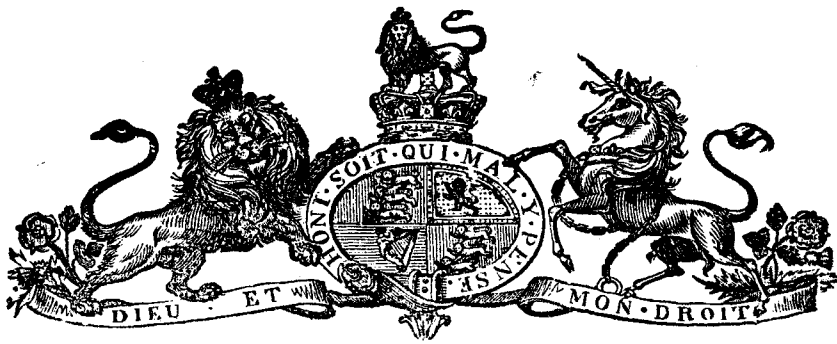

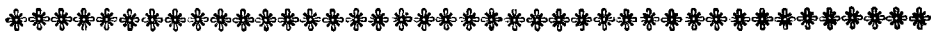

AN ACT to appropriate certain Sums arising A.D. 1877.
 from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the
 Service of the Colony of *Tasmania* for the
 Year 1877. [13 November, 1877.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* of the 40th *Victoria*, No. 21, is hereby repealed: Provided that all payments out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of *Tasmania*, duly made since the passing of the said Act in pursuance thereof, and before the commencement of this Act, shall be deemed to have been duly made notwithstanding such repeal. Repeal of
40 Vict. No. 21.

2 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of *Tasmania* there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, for the several purposes hereinafter mentioned, any sums of money not exceeding in amount respectively the several sums of money hereinafter specified; that is to say,

3 The Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund. Moneys payable by Warrant of the Governor.

4 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly. Credit to be given in Treasurer's Accounts.

5 The said sums of money shall not be issued or applied to any use, intent or purpose other than those mentioned. Application of moneys
