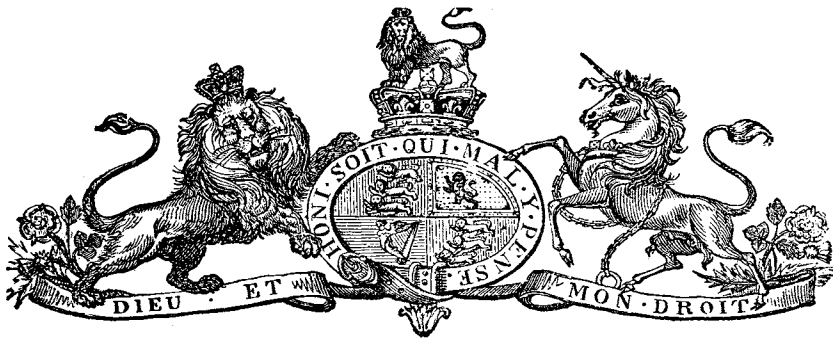

AN ACT to authorise the Appropriation of A.D. 1886.
certain Moneys for the Construction and
Improvement of Streets of *Hobart* and
Launceston. [8 December, 1886.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to the Municipal Council of the City of *Hobart* any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Three thousand seven hundred and fifty Pounds (£3750), in and towards the construction and improvement of the Streets within the said City: Provided that before any sum of money shall be paid hereunder in any year, the said Municipal Council shall furnish to the Treasurer satisfactory proof that a like sum has been already expended by the Council in the same year in and towards the construction and improvement of the Streets within the said City.

£3750 to be payable to Municipal Council of *Hobart* for construction, &c. of Streets.

2 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to the Municipal Council of the Town of *Launceston* any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Two thousand five hundred Pounds (£2500), in and towards the construction and improvement of the Streets within the said Town: Provided that before any sum of money shall be paid hereunder in any year, the said Municipal Council shall furnish to the Treasurer satisfactory proof that a like sum has been already expended by the Council in the same year in and towards the construction and improvement of the Streets within the said Town.
