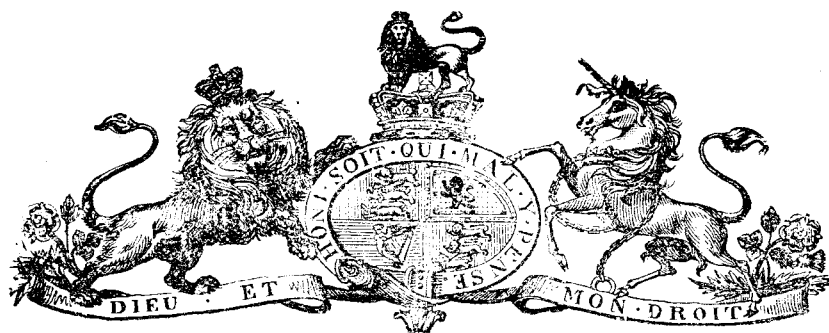

AN ACT to authorise the Marine Board of A.D. 1900.
Hobart to pay a certain Gratuity.
[15 *December*, 1900.]

WHEREAS the Marine Board of *Hobart* (hereinafter referred to as "the said Board") desires to pay a Gratuity to the Children of Captain *John Anderson*, deceased, formerly an Officer of the said Board: PREAMBLE.

And whereas under the existing Acts the said Board is not empowered to pay any sum of money as a Gratuity to the Children of such deceased Officer:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the said Board, out of the funds at its disposal, to pay the sum of Fifty-six Pounds Five Shillings as a Gratuity to the Children of the said Captain *John Anderson*, deceased. Gratuity to Children of late Captain *Anderson*.
