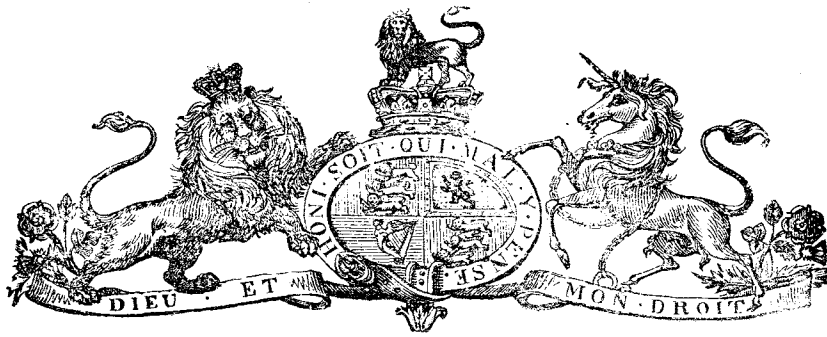

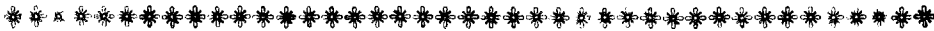

AN ACT to further amend "The Stamp Duties Act, 1882." [18 October, 1900.] A.D. 1900

WHEREAS it is desirable to repeal Section Ten of "The Stamp Duties Act, 1882," by which it is enacted that postage stamps may be used for the purposes of the said Act : PREAMBLE. 46 Vict. No. 34.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

- 1 Section Ten of "The Stamp Duties Act, 1882," is hereby repealed. Repeal Sect. 10, 46 Vict. No. 34.
- 2 It shall not be lawful for any person to use for the purposes of "The Stamp Duties Act, 1882," or any amendment thereof, stamps made and sold under the provisions of any Act relating to the Post Office. Postage stamps not to be used.
- 3 This Act shall come into operation and take effect on and after the First day of *December*, One thousand nine hundred, Date of Act.
