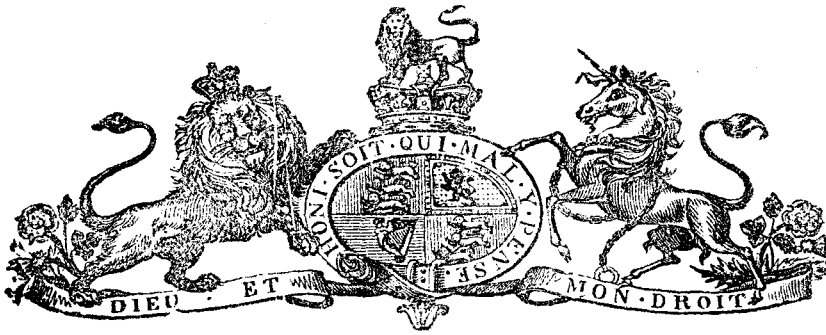

AN ACT to increase the Salary of the Solicitor-General. A.D. 1877.
[11 December, 1877.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 From and after the Thirty-first day of *December*, 1876, the annual sum of Four hundred and fifty Pounds shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this Colony as the salary of the Solicitor-General; and the provisions of Section Thirty of *The Constitutional Act* shall be applicable in respect of the said sum in the same manner as if that sum had been inserted in the Schedule B. of that Act instead of the sum therein specified as the salary of the Solicitor-General. Instead of sum named in Schedule B. of 18 Vict. No. 17, the sum fixed by this Act to be payable to the Solicitor-General.

2 From and after the Thirty-first day of *December*, 1876, so much of *An Act to reduce the Salaries of certain Officers* as fixes the salary of the Solicitor-General shall be repealed. Repeal of 30 Vict. No. 9, so far as relates to the Salary of the Solicitor-General.
