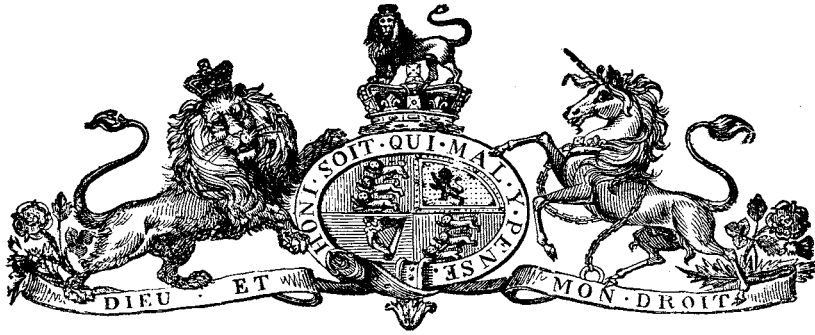

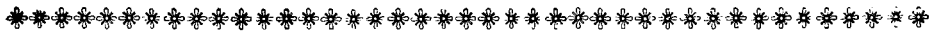

AN ACT to release and discharge the Trustees of the Road District of *Tarleton* from the Payment of certain Sums of Money. A.D. 1887.
[20 December, 1887.]

WHEREAS under "The Roads Loans Act," the Colonial Treasurer, with the approval of the Governor in Council, did, on the 23rd day of December, 1873, advance and lend to the Trustees of the Road District of *Tarleton* the sum of Five hundred Pounds, and, on the 30th March, 1874, a further sum of Five hundred Pounds: PREAMBLE.

And whereas no part of the said sums of money or either of them has been repaid to the said Treasurer, and it is expedient to release and discharge the said Trustees from the payment of the said sums of money and all interest payable in respect of the same respectively:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Trustees of the Road District of *Tarleton* and their successors are hereby released and discharged from the payment of the sums of Five hundred Pounds and Five hundred Pounds which have been advanced and lent to the said Trustees by the Colonial Treasurer as aforesaid, and every part thereof, and all interest payable in respect thereof, and the said Treasurer is hereby indemnified in respect of the said sums respectively and all interest thereon. *Tarleton Road Trust discharged from repayment of loans under 35 Vict. No. 7.*
