

AN ACT to repeal the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 22nd Victoria, No. 38. [23 September, 1859.]

WHEREAS by the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* of the PREAMBLE. 22nd Victoria, No. 38, authority was given for raising such Sum or Sums of Money, not exceeding £6000, as might be required for the construction and completion of the several Public Works set out in the Schedule to the said Act, by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the Land Fund: And whereas it is not intended to proceed with such Public Works, and consequently such Sum will not be required to be raised, and no Debentures having been issued or sold under the provisions of the said Act, it is expedient that the said Act should be repealed : Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, that the said Act of the Parliament Repeals 22 Vict. of Tasmania of the 22nd Victoria, No. 38, shall be, and the same is No. 38. hereby repealed.
