BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,

follows:—

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

I. By inserting at the end of section thirty-six thereof the following new subsection (6)—

“(6) The provisions of subsection (4) hereof shall apply in respect of any refusal of the Council to approve of any plans submitted to it under this Act in relation to any building or proposed building, and an appeal against such refusal may be had as therein provided within seven days after the same is notified to the applicant.”: and

Section 30.

II. As to section sixty thereof by deleting—

(a) “(2)” where secondly occurring and substituting “(3)”: and

(b) “(1)” in the second line of subsection (3) and substituting “(2)”.
