

## Offences.

**3** Section eleven of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting in paragraph (a) of subsection (4), after the word “inspector”, the words “or a police officer”;
- (b) by omitting from that paragraph the word “or” occurring at the end thereof;
- (c) by inserting in paragraph (b) of that subsection, after the word “under”, the words “subsection (1) of”; and
- (d) by inserting after that paragraph the following paragraph:—

“; or

“(c) fails to comply with a requirement made under subsection (6) of that section or, in response thereto, gives information that is false.”.

Consequential amendments of *Police Offences Act 1935*.

**4**—(1) Section fifty-eight A of the *Police Offences Act 1935* is repealed.

(2) Section fifty-nine of the *Police Offences Act 1935* is amended—

- (a) by inserting at the end of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) the word “or”;
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) of that subsection the word “or” occurring at the end thereof;
- (c) by omitting paragraph (c) of that subsection; and
- (d) by omitting from that subsection the words “or paragraph (c)”.

## CREMATION.

---

### No. 29 of 1963.

AN ACT to amend the *Cremation Act 1934*.

[18 September 1963.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Cremation Act 1963*.

(2) The *Cremation Act 1934*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** After section five of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

“5A—(1) A cremation authority may, with the approval of the Minister, make and publish in the *Gazette* a scale of fees payable for or in relation to— Fees in relation to cremations, &c.

- (a) the cremation of human remains at or in any crematory conducted by the authority;
- (b) the preservation of ashes at, in, or in any specified part of, any such crematory; and
- (c) any other service rendered by the cremation authority at, in, or in any specified part of, any such crematory.

“(2) In this section ‘cremation authority’ means the local authority, trustees, or other person by which or by whom a crematory is maintained and conducted.”

**3** Section six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (g) thereof. Regulations.

## PRINTERS AND NEWSPAPERS.

**No. 30 of 1963.**

AN ACT to amend the *Printers and Newspapers Act 1911.* [18 September 1963.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Printers and Newspapers Act 1963.* Short title and citation.

(2) The *Printers and Newspapers Act 1911*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section two of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from the definition of “newspaper” the words “, at a price of sixpence or any less amount”. Interpretation.
