ANALYSIS

1. Short title.

AN ACT to grant and apply a sum from the Consolidated Revenue for the service of the year ending on 30th June 1977, and to appropriate the sum thereby granted.

[20 April 1977]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Consolidated Revenue Fund Appropriation Act (No. 4) 1976-1977*. Short title.

Issue and application of moneys.

2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending 30th June 1977 the sum of \$265,000.

Appropriation of supplies.

3 The sum issued and applied pursuant to section 2 is appropriated for the purpose expressed in the Schedule.

Grants to Dairy Factories for the purposes of repayment of loans under the *State Advances Act 1935* and interest on those loans \$265,000.
