AN ACT to amend the *Devonport Sewerage Act* 1930 and to authorise the Council of the Municipality of Devonport to borrow a further sum of Seventeen thousand Pounds for the purposes of that Act. [30 October, 1936.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Devonport Sewerage Act* Short title. 1936.

2 It shall be lawful for the Council, in addition to any moneys already borrowed under the Principal Act, to borrow any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of seventeen thousand pounds for the purpose of defraying the cost and expenses of and incidental to the extension, carrying out, and completion of all or any of the works or objects authorised by the said Act.

Purposes of loan.

3 All moneys authorised by this Act to be borrowed shall be in addition to the amount authorised by the provisions of paragraph 1. of section three of the Principal Act.

Mode of borrowing.

4 All moneys raised or borrowed under this Act shall be subject to the provisions of the Principal Act in the same manner as if such moneys had been raised or borrowed under the Principal Act.
