"XXV Given for or upon the payment of any money paid by way of compensation or other benefit to any person under the provisions of the Workers' Compensation Act 1927 or of the Workers' (Occupational Diseases) Relief Fund Act 1954.".

EDUCATION.

No. 15 of 1958.

AN ACT to amend the *Education Act* 1932. [3 July 1958.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Education Act 1958. Short title
