EDUCATION.

No. 15 of 1958.

AN ACT to amend the *Education Act 1932.*
[3 July 1958.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Education Act 1958.*

Short title
and citation.

(2) The *Education Act 1932*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section three of the Principal Act is amended—

Interpreta-
tion.

(a) by omitting from subsection (1) thereof the definition of “Class”;

(b) by omitting from that subsection the definition of “Grade” and substituting therefor the following definition:—

“ ‘ Kind ’, used in relation to a kind of school, refers to the progressive stages of education of the scholars thereat:”;

- (c) by adding at the end of that subsection the following definition:—

“ ‘ Type ’, used in relation to a type of school, refers to the type of education given thereat.”;

- (d) by omitting from paragraph I of subsection (2) thereof the word “ secondary ” and substituting therefor the word “ post-primary ”, and by omitting from that paragraph all the words after the word “ education ” (second occurring) to the end of that paragraph; and
- (e) by omitting from paragraph II of that subsection all the words after the word “ education ” (second occurring) to the end of that paragraph.

State schools.

3 Section five of the Principal Act is amended by inserting therein, before the word “ kinds ” (wherever occurring), the word “ types,”.

Enrolment of children.

4 Section seven A of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting therefrom the word “ secondary ” (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word “ post-primary ”; and
- (b) by omitting from subsection (3) the word “ grade ” and substituting therefor the word “ kind ”.

Compulsory attendance at primary schools.

5 Section eight of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) thereof the word “ grade ” and substituting therefor the word “ kind ”.

Registration of schools.

6 Section thirty-six of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting in subsection (1) thereof, after the word “ graded ”, the words “, according to the kind of school,”, and by omitting from that subsection the word “ grades ” and substituting therefor the word “ kinds ”;
- (b) by omitting paragraph v of that subsection and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—
“ v Post-primary:”;
- (c) by omitting from subsections (2) and (3) the word “ grade ” (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word “ kind ”.

Registration of teachers.

7 Section thirty-seven of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph II of subsection (4) thereof the word “ grade ” and substituting therefor the word “ kind ”.

8 Section thirty-eight of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (2) thereof the word "grade" and substituting therefor the word "kind". Applications for registration.

9 Section thirty-nine of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the word "grade" and substituting therefor the word "kind". Registrations under previous Act.

10 Section forty-five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph IV thereof the word "grade" and substituting therefor the word "kind". By-laws.

11 Section forty-six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the word "grade" (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "kind". Offences.

12 Section forty-seven of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph I of subsection (1) thereof the word "secondary" and substituting therefor the word "post-primary". Regulations.

TRAFFIC.

No. 16 of 1958.

AN ACT to amend the *Traffic Act 1925*.

[3 July 1958.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Traffic Act 1958*.

(2) The *Traffic Act 1925*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act. Short title and citation.

2 Section thirty-seven of the Principal Act is amended— Unauthorized use of motor vehicle.
 (a) by inserting after subsection (2) thereof the following subsection:—

“ (2A) The provisions of section fifty-five of the *Police Offences Act 1935* extend and apply where a person is found offending (within the meaning of that section) against subsection (1) of this section.”; and
