AN ACT to amend the *Forestry Act* 1954.
[11 April 1957.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Forestry Act* 1957.
(2) The *Forestry Act* 1954 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Special licences.

2 Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (4) thereof the words “a further period of not more than three months” and substituting therefor the words “any further period or periods not exceeding twelve months in the aggregate”.

Short title and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Companies Act* 1957.
(2) The *Companies Act* 1920, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
