AN ACT to amend the *Gillies' Pension Act 1935*. A.D.
1944
[14 December, 1944.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Gillies' Pension Act* Short title and citation.

(2) The *Gillies' Pension Act 1935** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Gillies' Pension.

A.D. 1944. **2** After section two of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

Pension to
widow of
J. H. Gillies.

“**3** After the death of the said *James Hynds Gillies* there shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue to his widow, during her life, an annual pension of one hundred and fifty pounds.”.

Commencement. **3** This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the date of the commencement of the Principal Act.
