AN ACT to amend the *Hobart Corporation Securities Act 1930.* [22 July, 1942.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Hobart Corporation Securities Act 1942.* Short title.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by expunging the last four lines of schedule (6) thereof and substituting therefor the following:— Amendment of 21 Geo. V., No. 32, schedule (6).

“ATTESTATION.—The witness must be one of the following persons residing in the State in which the transfer is signed—

- (a) A Justice of the Peace for the State:

- (c) A bank manager:
- (d) A medical practitioner: or
- (e) A member of a recognised stock exchange.”
