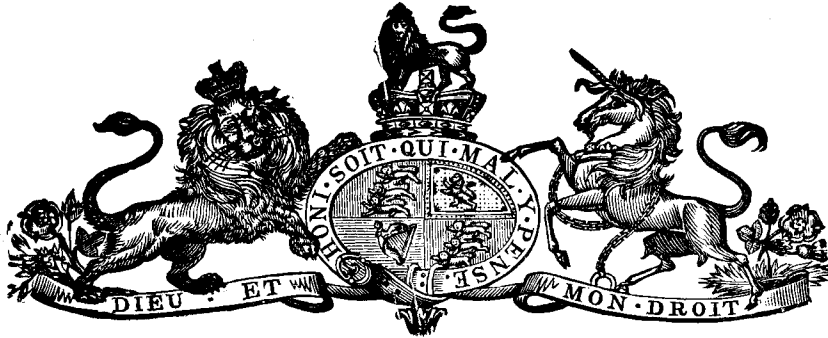

The River Derwent and its tributaries above the Town of New Norfolk: Provided, that the place at which the Corporation may take and divert the waters of such river and its tributaries shall be subject to the approval of the Hydro-Electric Commission, and such taking and diversion shall be subject to such conditions as the Governor may determine.”</p> | Additional sources of supply.
