BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Marine Act 1941*.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

I. By inserting at the end of section six thereof the following new subsection (6)—

“ (6) The Marine Board of Mersey shall hereafter for all purposes be known as the Marine Board of Devonport.”:

II. By deleting the word “Mersey” in section twenty-seven thereof and substituting “Devonport”:

III. As to section forty-four thereof, by inserting—

(a) “ (1) ” at the commencement: and

(b) “ (2) No person who is disqualified under the provisions of this section shall—

i. Accept office: or

ii. Continue to act—

as a warden or trustee while subject to such disqualification.

Penalty: Fifty pounds”: and

IV. By deleting the word “Mersey” in the second and third schedules thereto respectively and substituting “Devonport.”
