# AN ACT to amend the *Marine Act* 1921. [19 December 1958.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Marine Act 1958.

Short title and citation.

- (2) The  $Marine\ Act\ 1921$ , as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- **2** Section sixty-four of the Principal Act is amended by General powers of omitting paragraph XVI and substituting therefor the follow-boards. ing paragraphs:—
  - "XVI To let, or grant a licence to use or occupy, any wharf, work, building, or land for a term not exceeding three years, or, with the consent of the Governor, for a term not exceeding twenty years:
  - "XVIA To let any land on a building lease, with the consent of the Governor, for a term not exceeding ninety-nine years:".

# AN ACT to amend the *Firewood Act* 1951. [19 December 1958.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Firewood Act 1958. Short title (2) The Firewood Act 1951, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 Section seven of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—
- "7 This Act shall expire on the thirty-first day of Decem-Expiry of ber 1959.".
