MATRIMONIAL CAUSES.

No. 28 of 1959.

AN ACT to amend the *Matrimonial Causes Act* 1874. [30 September 1959.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Matrimonial Causes Act* 1959.

(2) The *Matrimonial Causes Act* 1874, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section two of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsections (2) and (3) and substituting therefor the following subsections:—

Orders for maintenance.

“(2) The Court may, for good cause shown, vary or discharge any such order or temporarily suspend any provisions thereof or revive any provisions thereof so varied, discharged, or suspended, at any time, and in considering any application for that purpose shall have regard to all the circumstances of the case, including any increase or decrease in the means of either of the parties to the marriage and any material alteration in the circumstances of either of those parties.

“(3) No such order as is mentioned in subsection (2) of this section shall be made to take effect from a date prior to the filing of the application therefor, except in special circumstances.”.

COMPANIES.

No. 29 of 1959.

AN ACT to consolidate and amend the law relating to companies. [30 September 1959.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PART I.

PRELIMINARY.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Companies Act 1959*.

Short title and commencement.

(2) This Act shall commence on a date to be fixed by proclamation.

2—(1) The Acts that are specified in Part I of the first schedule to this Act are repealed.

Repeals and amendments.

(2) The Acts that are specified in Part II of the first schedule to this Act are amended as respectively specified in that Part of that schedule.
