2 Section eight of the Principal Act is hereby amended—

I. By deleting the words “at any time” to “forty” (inserted in subsection (1) by the *Mortgage Interest Reduction Act 1938*) and substituting therefor the words “during the continuance of the war in which His Majesty is now engaged or within six months after the termination thereof”: and

II. By inserting at the end of subsection (2) the words “and the costs and fees in relation thereto shall be in accordance with such scales and rates as may be prescribed.”.
